Field Day. In spite of the poor conditions on the upper HF bands we had a pretty good Field Day this year. We operated in the 2A category (2 HF stations operating on emergency power) with a HF SSB voice station and a CW/Digital mode station. In addition, we had a VHF/Satellite station.

Because of the poor band conditions, the 2 HF stations had to operate on the same band during the day. The interference between the two stations made it difficult to hear stations. In the evening, when 40 meters became active, we had considerable success on both stations. Both stations racked up a considerable number of contacts in the evening hours. Paul, AA6PZ and Richard, N6ATD operated the SSB station on 40 meters in the hours near midnight to pull in the contacts. In spite of this, 20 meters was our best band.

The Satellite station also had a challenging time since two of the best satellites for Field Day failed to be available. However, Phil, KA6MZE, managed to obtain the minimum one contact required to get the bonus points.

As usual we had a very good turnout for the BBQ on Saturday. Thanks to Peter, WA6VAQ for making this run as smooth as ever.
