Rigblaster No-Mic Kit

First prize is a Rigblaster No-Mic Rig to Soundcard Interface with USB. The kit includes the RIGblaster nomic, a 3-foot 8 Pin Round Circular Mic Cable, a 3-foot RJ45 Mic Cable, a USB Interface Cable, a 6-foot DB9M to DB9F Serial Cable, two 6-foot Mini Plug Audio Cables, an Owners Manual, and a free CD-ROM with software.



MAHA Battery Charger MH-C9000

Second prize is a Maha AA/AAA Deluxe Battery Charger MH-C9000. It has four independent slots, like having four charger-analyzers for AA and AAA NiMH / NiCD batteries. The large backlit LCD display digitally displays capacity, voltage, time and current. It is programmable with 29 selectable charging and discharging rates.



Grundig FR-250 Radio

Third prize is a Grundig (Eton), American Red Cross FR-250 Portable Emergency Radio. Be prepared and aware! This portable receives AM (530-1710 kHz), FM (88-108 MHz) and seven major shortwave bands. This radio can be powered from four different sources: 1) From the built-in rechargeable Ni-MH rechargeable battery that takes charge from the dynamo crank and from an AC adaptor (AC adaptor not included). 2) From 3 regular AA batteries (not supplied). 3) From the AC adaptor alone (AC adaptor not included). 4) From the dynamo crank alone, even with no battery pack installed.

How to get to FARS Club meetings (Visitors always welcome)

DIRECTIONS:

From Interstate 280. take the El Monte exit Northeast. Cross Foothill Expressway. (A) At the first traffic light turn right on Covington. (B) Immediately at the fork take the left street (Covington). Go about 1/10th of a mile. Turn left into the parking lot. The gym is the tall building to your right with red and white stripes.

From Foothill Expwy., take the El Monte exit and go Northeast; then follow directions as above at point (A).

From US101 or El Camino: take San Antonio Road west (to Foothill Expressway). Then follow directions above at point (A).

TALK-IN via the N6NFI (145.230-; 100Hz PL) repeater or the W6ASH 145.27- (100Hz PL) repeater.
