## **April Meeting Report**

Mikel Lechner, KN6QI, talked about "Keyboarding in HF" (posted at <u>http://www.fars.k6ya.org/docs/digital</u>). There are many keyboarding modes: PSK31, PSK63, PSK125, MFSK16/8/32, RTTY and more. You need a SSB HF transceiver, an interface cable, a computer with a sound card, and software (which can be found for free on the internet). Mikel built his own interface cable that can work with most any computer. The interface components were placed in the connector housing. There are two circuits: the sound interface and the radio PTT control. Mikel uses the Hamscope software. Check <u>www.fars.k6ya.org/docs/links</u> for useful links.




