
QSL Cards

Radio Amateurs in Germany have a huge encyclopedic antenna book as big or bigger than the ARRL Antenna Book. It is *Rothammel's Antennenbuch*, first published in 1959 and now in its 12th edition.

Its 997 pages contain much that is different or not in other antenna books. It is published in German, not English, and is available only from the publisher DARC Verlag GmBH in Germany.

The book costs 48.60 EUR, or about \$65 USD. However, shipping and handling from Germany are expensive, about \$40 per book when ordered individually. So we are considering a group purchase that would enable FARS members to obtain copies at a reduced shipping rate per book.



After all signups are in, Steve will send out a confirmation with the final price, which will be between \$65 and \$105 per book depending on the number of people who sign up.

Your book should arrive approximately three weeks after the order is placed. In addition to discovering new antennas, this opportunity is an excellent motivation to learn German.



Directions

The easiest way to find Michael's is to take highway 101 to Mountain View. Exit onto Shoreline Blvd. (aka Stierlin Road) north (towards the bay). Follow for about 1 mile until you reach the gate for Shoreline Park. Alternatively, you can exit onto Amphitheatre Parkway from 101 and follow it north/east (towards the bay) to Shoreline Blvd. Turn left (north) onto Shoreline and follow until you reach the gate for Shoreline Park.

Enter the park through the gate, which will be open. Follow the road $(\sim 3/4 \text{ mi.})$ in a wide left curve around the park. Look for a sign pointing left for Michael's. Take a left turn and enter the parking lot. The building next to the parking lot is Michael's.

How to get to FARS meetings (Visitors are always welcome)

Meetings are held at the Covington Elementary School (directions below) on the fourth Friday. Socializing at 7 PM with the regular meeting at 7:30 PM. There may be changes in the meeting dates for January, June, November, and December.

DIRECTIONS:

From Interstate 280. take the El Monte exit Northeast. Cross Foothill Expressway. (A) At the first traffic light turn right on Covington. (B) Immediately at the fork take the left street (Covington). Go about 1/10th of a mile. Turn left into the parking lot. The gym is the tall building to your right with red and white stripes.

From Foothill Expwy., take the El Monte exit and go Northeast; then follow directions as above at point (A).

From US101 or El Camino: take San Antonio Road west (to Foothill Expressway). Then follow directions above at point (A).
