OPERATING REPORT: 2012 CQ WORLDWIDE 160M PHONE CONTEST



The night of Saturday, February 25^{th} FARS participated in this annual event, the <u>CQWW 160-Meter Contest</u>. Our operation included a 300 foot Beverage antenna for receive (photo below) and a quarter wavelength (135 foot) sloper antenna for transmit. Phil KA6MZE spearheaded the event, now in its 4^{th} year.



The objective of the contest was for amateurs around the world to contact other amateurs in as many U.S. states, Canadian provinces, and countries as possible utilizing the 160 meter band.

FARS had a claimed score of 10,352 points, with 115 QSO's and 41 multipliers!

A big thank you goes out to Maryknoll Residences in Los Altos for kindly allowing us the use of their soccer field, the same QTH used by FARS for both Field Day and the California QSO Party. Thank you to Phil Hawkins KA6MZE for your hard work each year on this contest. Thank you also to Phil's fellow volunteers and operators. This year the excellent crew included Clark KE6KXO, Kit WA6PWW, Keith KJ6PUO, Peter KJ6PUN, Mikel KN6QI, Jerry K6TXD, Rick N6DQ, and Joanna K6YL. Hopefully I have not missed anyone in this list. Our special guest not yet mentioned was Father Theisen, NC2E, who had just arrived at Maryknoll a week prior to the 160m contest and who had never before made a contact on 160m. We took care of that! Theisen was originally from Minnesota, but recently spent 38 years in southern Chile and is excited to get on the air from Los Altos.

REPORT: BAY AREA RADIO BUILDERS CLUB (BARC)



Kristen K6WX gave an excellent talk at the February BARC meeting.

She covered the DC voltage basics of Kirchhoff's laws and voltage dividers, then talked about what a closed feedback circuit is. She showed us multiple circuits including how to use opamps to build basic calculation components to add, subtract, multiply, divide, ln(x), differential and integral functions. Examples include an oscillator, comparator, function generator and a stereo amp.

How to get to FARS meetings (Visitors are always welcome)

Meetings are held at the Covington Elementary School (directions below) on the fourth Friday. Socializing at 7 PM with the regular meeting at 7:30 PM. There may be changes in the meeting dates for January, June, November, and December.

DIRECTIONS:

From Interstate 280. take the El Monte exit Northeast. Cross Foothill Expressway. (A) At the first traffic light turn right on Covington. (B) Immediately at the fork take the left street (Covington). Go about 1/10th of a mile. Turn left into the parking lot. The gym is the tall building to your right with red and white stripes.

From Foothill Expwy., take the El Monte exit and go Northeast; then follow directions as above at point (A).

From US101 or El Camino: take San Antonio Road west (to Foothill Expressway). Then follow directions above at point (A).

TALK-IN via the <u>N6NFI</u> (145.230-; 100Hz PL) repeater or the <u>W6ASH</u> 145.27- (100Hz PL) repeater.
