


REPORT: Pacificon 2012

enjoy it, whether it was the swap meet. seminars. vendor tables, banquet, or just catching up with friends.









Throughout the rest of the weekend we also enjoyed working W1AW/6 on 20m and 40m using the same configuration but adding additional wire.







Go about 1/10th of a mile. Turn left into the parking lot. The gym is the tall building to your right with red and white stripes.

From Foothill Expwy., take the El Monte exit and go Northeast; then follow directions as above at point (A).

From US101 or El Camino: take San Antonio Road west (to Foothill Expressway). Then follow directions above at point (A).
