FARS/PAARA Winter Banquet 2014. The banquet has been scheduled for January 17th, 2014. This activity is open to anyone who wants to attend, but reservations are required. We are working on a speaker for the banquet, but the venue and pricing have been determined.

We have decided on \$1500 for banquet raffle prizes this year, so there are a few more opportunities to win. The top prize is an Elecraft KX-3. This unit is a full-featured, all-mode HF Transceiver covering 160-6 meters. At only 1.5 pounds it features 10W PEP, and has a current draw as low as 150mA. The pricing for the banquet includes an 18% gratuity, 9.75% sales tax, and \$2 to cover other expenses including PayPal, speaker's meal(s), supplies, etc. The meal choices and prices are: Prime Rib \$45, Broiled Salmon \$39, Chicken Florentine \$32, Vegetarian Brochette with Rice \$30.

The easiest way to find Michael's is to take highway 101 to Mountain View. Exit onto Shoreline Blvd. (aka Stierlin Road) north (towards the bay). Follow for about 1 mile until you reach the gate for Shoreline Park. Alternatively, you can exit onto Amphitheatre Parkway from 101 and follow it north/east (towards the bay) to Shoreline Blvd. Turn left (north) onto Shoreline and follow until you reach the gate for Shoreline Park. Enter the park through the gate, which will be open. Follow the road (~3/4 mi.) in a wide left curve around the park. Look for a sign pointing left for Michael's. Take a left turn and enter the parking lot. The building next to the parking lot is Michael's.
